



Team 10 - 4 BBQ enjoyed success at the Apalachicola Red Snapper Roundup onboard Suzuki outboard-powered Alle Cat

Alle Cat Takes it All at the Red Snapper Roundup

Shawn repowered his Mako from an older Mercury outboard and upgraded with a new Suzuki DF250.

Brent Magsig, regional manager for Mastry Suzuki Repower Centers, along with Trae Ross, owner of Oyster City Suzuki, presented the award and the \$1000 to Shawn and his team.
